Incident: Burglary
Possession of stolen property
Parole Violation

Date/Time: January 2, 2012/ 4:55 PM

Location: 200 block of E. Henderson Avenue, Porterville

Suspect(s): Rory Trimmer, 52 years, Porterville resident

Narrative:

On January 2, 2012, at about 4:55 PM, Officers of the Porterville Police Department began a burglary investigation that occurred in the 200 block of E. Henderson Avenue. Officers determined the fence around the property had been cut and it appeared a vehicle had backed up to the fence. Inside the property a seatrain had been entered and furniture and exercise equipment was taken. Officers located tire tracks near the fence line and followed them to a nearby residence near the intersection of Fourth Street and Henderson Avenue. At the residence officers observed a vehicle that had the same tire tread as the pattern located at the crime scene. Also at the residence officers observed the stolen furniture and exercise equipment.

The resident, 52-year-old Rory Trimmer, was contacted and arrested for burglary and possession of stolen property. Because Trimmer is also on CDC Parole, a parole hold was issued. Trimmer was booked at the Porterville Substation on charges of burglary, possession of stolen property and a parole violation. This is the second time Trimmer has targeted this property. He was arrested a couple months ago after being found in possession of scrap metal he had stolen from the same property. These cases remain under investigation.
