Incident: Possession of Prescription Medication without Prescription
Tulare County Warrants

Date/Time: December 7, 2011/ 1:09 AM

Location: 100 block S. Chess Terrace, Porterville

Suspect: Jacob Sweeden, 30 years, Porterville resident

Narrative:

On December 7, 2011, at about 1:09 AM, Officer Barteau was dispatched to a disturbance in the 100 block of S. Chess Terrace. One of the involved parties, identified as 30 year old Jacob Sweeden, was contacted as he was walking away from the area. A subsequent record check revealed that Sweeden was wanted for three active Tulare County Arrest warrants. Sweeden was arrested for the warrants, and a search of his person incident to arrest showed he was in possession of three narcotic tablets without a prescription. Sweeden was booked into the custody of the Tulare County Sheriff's Department for the arrest warrants and being in possession of prescription medication without a prescription.
