Summary:

On January 1, 2010 Porterville Police Officers responded to an address in Porterville and contacted the victim of an auto theft. The victim reported her vehicle had been stolen by her son, Darryl Taylor. On January 2, 2010 at approximately 12:30 A.M. officers spotted the vehicle driving in the area of Olive Avenue and Villa Street. The vehicle was followed and ultimately stopped at Springville Avenue and Jaye Street. Officers detained the driver (identified as Darryl Taylor) and the passenger (identified as Miguel Rodriguez). Taylor was arrested for auto theft and Rodriguez was found to be wanted by State Parole for absconding. The vehicle was returned to the victim and both suspects were booked into the Tulare County Jail.
