



## **Porterville Police Department Press Release**

**Incident:** Felony Warrant Arrest (Sexual Assault)  
**Date/Time:** January 13, 2010/2:25 p.m.  
**Location:** 800 block N. Jaye Street, Porterville, CA  
**Suspects:** Kenneth Neal Mancini, 65 year old Porterville Resident

**Narrative:**

On January 13, 2010, at approximately 2:25 p.m. Detectives from the Porterville Police Department's General Investigations Unit arrested Kenneth Mancini on a felony warrant stemming from a sexual assault case originally reported on March 21, 2009.

On March 21, 2009, a confidential victim reported to the Porterville Police Department that she had been sexually assaulted and identified her assailant as Kenneth Mancini. Detectives were called out to investigate the allegations and based on the statements of the victim and evidence collected at the scene, arrested Mr. Mancini. At that time he was booked with the Tulare County Sheriff's Office. Shortly after his arrest, Mr. Mancini was released pending an examination of the evidence by the California Department of Justice.

Recently the results of that examination were completed and made available to investigators and the District Attorney's Office. With the results supporting the allegations made by the confidential victim, a felony warrant for the arrest of Mr. Mancini was issued. With the issuance of the warrant Detectives tracked down Mr. Mancini and arrested him without incident. He was subsequently booked with the Tulare County Sheriff's Office.
