**Incident:**                   **Possession of a Concealed Firearm, Possession of Prohibited Assault Weapons, Possession of Methamphetamine for Sale, Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and a Parole Violation**

**Narrative:**  
On February 23, 2010, Detective Chris Contreras observed a motorcycle at an excessive speed on Highway 65 at the Highway 190 interchange. Detective Contreras conducted a traffic stop and contacted the driver, Kenneth Fogle (7/13/71), and the passenger, Stormy Gonzales (6/27/77). Gonzales was found to be on C.D.C. Parole for auto theft. Detective Contreras detained Fogle for being under the influence of a controlled substance. During a search of Fogle, Detective Contreras located a loaded .38 caliber revolver inside of Fogle's jacket pocket. Also located in Fogle's motorcycle were methamphetamines, packaging material, a digital gram scale, and other narcotics sales paraphernalia.

Gonzales was also arrested for being under the influence of a controlled substance and a violation of parole. A search warrant was obtained for Fogle's residence. During the search, investigators located another seven firearms. The firearms located included two sawed-off shotguns, two full-size shotguns, two assault rifles, another .38 caliber revolver, and narcotics sales paraphernalia. Detectives also located numerous correspondences and other evidence that tied Fogle to the Ching-a-Ling Outlaw Motorcycle Gang.

Fogle and Gonzales were later booked into Tulare County Jail for charges of Possession of a Concealed Firearm, Possession of a Controlled Substance for Sale, Under the Influence of a Controlled Substance while armed with a firearm, Possession of Prohibited Assault Weapons, felon in possession of a firearm and Violation of Parole.
