Summary:

On February 14, 2010, at 10:01 p.m. officers conducted a traffic stop in the 1100 block of North Prospect. One male juvenile ran from officers after the stop. A handgun with the serial number removed was located concealed inside the vehicle. The driver, Lluriana Rocha Zamora, and two remaining juvenile passengers were arrested without incident. The passenger who ran was not located but was positively identified. Ms. Zamora and the two male juveniles were transported to the Porterville Police Department for booking.

Ms. Zamora was booked at the Tulare County Sheriffs Department, Bob Wiley Detention Facility, for Possession of a Concealed Firearm in a Vehicle, Possession of a Firearm with the Serial Number Removed, and Driving with a Suspended Drivers License; and was being held in lieu of \$35,000 bail.

The two male juveniles were booked at the Tulare County Juvenile Detention Center for Possession of a Concealed Firearm in a Vehicle by a Gang Member and Possession of a Firearm with Serial Number removed; and were being held without bail.

The outstanding male juvenile is still being sought for charges of Possession of a Firearm by a Gang Member, Possession of a Firearm with Serial Number Removed, Providing a False Name to a Police Officer, and Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer.
