**Summary:**

On January 23, 2010, at 6:53 p.m. officers were dispatched to the sub 100 block of West Olive Avenue regarding a theft of alcohol from a local retail business. Three male suspects assaulted employees who tried to detain them. All three suspects were able to get away before police arrived. Officers were given a description of the suspects and their vehicle.

At 9:38 p.m. the suspect vehicle was located in a parking lot in the 1200 block of West Henderson, along with several subjects. Witnesses were able to positively identify Jacob Malay, Angel Corona, and a 17 year old male juvenile as the suspects who took the alcohol and fought with employees. All three suspects were taken into custody without incident and transported to the Porterville Police Department for booking.

Mr. Malahy and Mr. Corona were booked at the Tulare County Sheriffs Department, Porterville Sub-Station, on charges of 211 PC-Robbery, and 182 PC-Conspiracy. Mr. Malahy is being held in lieu of \$50,000 bail. Mr. Corona was on Parole at the time and is additionally charged with 3056 PC-Violation of Parole, and is being held without bail.

The 17 year old male juvenile was booked at the Tulare County Juvenile Detention Facility on charges of 211 PC-Robbery, and 182 PC-Conspiracy and is being held without bail.
