

Sector 2 Report / End of Month – June

During the month of June, Officer Martinez attended the Business Watch meeting at the Police Department, along with other Police Department personnel. Those in attendance were provided with information on how to recognize and identify counterfeit currency and a special agent from the Treasury department was present to disseminate the information. Prior to the meeting, Sector 2 Officers passed out numerous business watch fliers to several businesses located within Sector 2.

During the month of June, Officer Martin continued working with Code Enforcement to restore the residence in the 100 block of north Martin, which had fallen to a less than desirable condition due to vacancy. At this time, the debris and weeds from around the residence has been removed and the grass has been trimmed. Officer Martin will continue to monitor the condition of the residence to ensure it does not return to its previous status.

During the month of June, Officer White continued working with Code Enforcement to restore the residence of 800 block of East Putnam, which had also fallen to a less than desirable appearance. At this time, the debris and weeds from around the residence have been removed, the grass has been trimmed and “no trespassing” signs have been erected around the residence. Family members of the original property owner, who is now deceased, are currently awaiting a financial ruling regarding the disposition of the property. Officer White will continue to monitor this residence to ensure it does not return to its previous status.

During the month of June, Officer Martin was assigned to locate all non functioning street lights within Sector 2 and make proper notification to have them repaired. At the conclusion of his detail, Officer Martin located three inoperable streets lights in various areas and made proper notification for repair. Two of the lights have been repaired and Officer Martin will check the final street light upon his return to work.

During the month of June, Officer Bray was assigned to locate shoes dangling from telephone poles or power lines within Sector 2. At the conclusion of his detail, Officer Bray located one set of shoes dangling from some power lines in the area of Doris and North. Officer Bray notified Southern California Edison and will continue to monitor this area to ensure the shoes are removed.

During the month of June, Officer Bray also followed up with the apartment manger of 870 N. Plano, Stacie Bustillos, regarding National Night Out. The apartment complex will be hosting their own National Night Out on August 3, 2010, and certain Sector 2 Officers will be present, including Officer Miller for a canine demonstration.
