SUBJECT: End of Month Report/Sector 3/December 2011

Over the course of the month, Sector 3 officers conducted several checks of transients on the Tule River between Plano Street and Jaye Street. Due to the cold weather only a few transients were contacted and advised to seek shelter.

On December 30, 2011, Officer Dominguez and Traffic Officer Mark Azevedo conducted traffic enforcement at high collision intersections in Sector 3. This detail resulted in over ten traffic citations being issued to motorists.

Sector 3 officers continued concentrating on narcotic related issues in the 100 and 200 block of E. Orange Avenue. Officer's contacted and arrested several subjects for theft, narcotics and arrest warrants. Officers also identified suspects who are possibly selling illegal narcotics. This information was turned over to the Special Investigations Unit for further investigation. Sector 3 officers also continued the efforts in serving warrants from the Sector 3 warrant book. This was to help in the reduction of the above specific crimes, serve the active warrants, and reduce the arrest warrants. Officers served several arrest warrants, which also led to fresh arrests such as subjects being under the influence and possession of a controlled substance.

Sector 3 officers also conducted regular foot patrols and area checks of Murry Park to ensure that no gang or graffiti activity was occurring. Sector 3 officers also continued extra enforcement efforts in the Mohoff Court and Doree Street area.
