SUBJECT: Sector 4/End of Month Report/November 2011

During the month of November 2011, Officers assigned to Sector 4 were Officer Contreras, Officer Skamel, Officer Tashiro and Officer Dean.

On November 28, 2011, two stolen motorcycles were located inside the garage of a residence in the 1900 block of W. Union Avenue.

Officer Skamel also contacted management at 45 N. Salisbury (Alder Apartments) who expressed interest in another Micro Step Up event similar to the one the Porterville Police Department participated in at the complex in September 2011. Officer Skamel is working on organizing and putting this event together with the assistance of Crime Prevention Officer Harper.

Officer Tashiro focused on traffic enforcement during the morning hours at the intersection of Olive Avenue and Villa Street, due to heavy vehicle and pedestrian traffic. Officer Tashiro also spent time on traffic enforcement at Westwood Street and Olive Avenue, due to speeders.

Officer Tashiro continues to contact transients on or near Olive Avenue. Business owners have expressed their appreciation and advised they have noticed a difference.

On November 3, 2011, Officer Tashiro and I attended a Micro Step Up event at 450 W. Springville Avenue. During this event Officer Tashiro interacted with the tenants and made himself available to answer questions and address concerns brought to his attention.

Officer Tashiro contacted management at Mission Bell to establish a date for a community outreach meeting regarding recent phone scams. Officer Tashiro is waiting to hear back from management with a potential date.
